Lyrarakis 2015 Dafni Crete, Greece	£25.50

<i>Verdicchio but not as you know it - thick and intense with added complexity from extended time on its lees.</i>		
ORANGE Nino Barraco 2014 Zibibbo Sicily, Italy		£82.00
<i>A bone dry, intensely aromatic wine left in contact with its skins for 15 days. Heady with citrus, spice, and wild flowers.</i>
